Carolyn Owens, who stars as Dominique in the film *Reunion*, has been an actor since age four, when she saw Lucille Ball's antics on *I Love Lucy*. Despite her calling, Carolyn grew up in a small Texas town where empowering an African-American girl was not especially fostered. As a close substitute, since it involved both acting and dressing the part, Carolyn became a lawyer. In so doing, she attended University of Southern California, graduating summa cum laude before continuing to law school at the University of California at Los Angeles.

Carolyn's legal career progressed in the public sector as a criminal prosecutor in Los Angeles County's District Attorney's office and in the private sector as a litigator, ultimately leading her to become the Administrative Law Judge for the State of California. Over the years, Carolyn continued to think about acting, especially after seeing a really good movie! Finally, it just so happened that her career as a judge was placed on hold and she decided to change career paths to make her acting dream a reality. Since that time, Carolyn has landed parts in feature films such as *Watson*, *Sherlock and Me*, *Damsel of Death*, and *You Can't Buy Love*. Carolyn has also been in several commercials, videos and played the lead in an episode of *It's A Miracle* on PAX TV.

Carolyn credits Lucille Ball for an epiphany that inspired her love for the craft of acting. "I am at my best, most alive, when I'm on set. I love comedy, drama, and all the in between stuff...actually, it's the in between stuff that I find I love the most."
